THINGS TO KNOW

SEPTEMBER - JANUARY

- **SHARING THE EDUCATION HANDBOOK WITH COLLEAGUES**
Send the PDF version of the Education Handbook to your colleagues.
- **WEBINARS FOR TEACHERS**
Register for the webinar after receiving the email invitation and encourage the teachers involved in the project to join.
- **CIRCULARS**
Keep colleagues and families informed about the project using the circulars available on the materials page.
- **PRINTED MATERIALS (SOLIDARITY PASSPORTS, BROCHURES, BIBS, ETC.)**
Check that all printed materials arrive at school and make sure the quantities match the number of students enrolled in the project.
- **PLANNING CLASSROOM ACTIVITIES**
Arrange a call with Azione Contro la Fame team to confirm dates and times.

FEBRUARY - APRIL

- **CLASSROOM LEARNING SESSIONS**
Check that the interactive whiteboard or projector and an audio system are working properly in the classrooms where the sessions will take place.
Inform students about the upcoming meeting with the Azione Contro la Fame expert.
- **DISTRIBUTING MATERIALS**
Hand out the Solidarity Passport and the information brochure for parents.
- **SOLIDARITY PASSPORTS**
Regularly encourage students to make use of their Solidarity Passport.

MAY

- **SOLIDARITY PASSPORTS**
Go around the classes to check that no one has lost their passport and that everyone has been using it.
- **DATE AND VENUE FOR THE FINAL EVENT**
Decide the date, location, and format of the final event and share the details with the school contacts at Action Against Hunger.
- **STUDENT DONATIONS**
Schedule a specific “appointment” with each class for the day donations will be collected.
- **PRINTED MATERIALS (SOLIDARITY PASSPORTS, BROCHURES, BIBS, ETC.)**
Check that all printed materials have arrived at school and make sure the quantities match the number of students enrolled in the project.
- **PAYMENT**
Make the payment via bank transfer or postal slip. Decide whether to manage the collection and payment yourself, as the coordinator, or to involve other people (teachers or parents).

HOW DOES THE SOLIDARITY PASSPORT WORK?

Each student receives a small booklet called the Solidarity Passport. It helps them talk to family and friends about hunger and malnutrition using what they learned in class. Sponsors can pledge a donation for each lap the student runs during the Sports Day.

This simple tool encourages students to take action, improves their **communication skills**, and helps them feel like they are **part of the solution**.

HOW TO ORGANIZE THE FINAL EVENT

THE ACTIVITY IS FLEXIBLE - EACH SCHOOL CAN CHOOSE HOW TO DO IT.

- DATE:** We suggest a national date, but the school may choose to hold the event in March or April, on multiple dates, or during Physical Education lessons within individual classes. The run must take place by the end of May. The experts who attend the educational sessions will not be able to be present during the runs. The final event is organized independently by the school.
- FORMAT:** The final event can be a run, a walk, a series of individual challenges, or other similar activities. It can be done all together on the same day, or over several days within individual classes during Physical Education lessons.
- LOCATION:** It can be held in the gym, in the schoolyard, through the streets of the town, in a city park, or any other space available to the school. If the school wishes to organize a municipal-level event, it will be responsible for requesting the necessary permits.
- PARTICIPANTS:** In addition to students, the school can decide whether to involve or invite teachers, parents, and other members of the local community to participate or watch.

What if it rains?
You can carry out the activity during Physical Education hours with individual classes, hold it indoors in the gym or reschedule the event.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR COLLECTING DONATIONS AFTER THE RACE

Each student will bring back their envelope with the donations. The school will be able to choose who will be in charge of collecting the class envelopes and making the payment. We suggest four possible options:

- The project coordinator, who will be responsible for collecting the envelopes from all the classes and making a single bank transfer or payment slip for all the collected donations.
- The parents' representative, who will collect all the envelopes from each class and make a single bank transfer or payment slip.
- The class collection managers, who will each collect the envelopes from their own class and make a separate bank transfer or payment slip for each class.
- The school itself, which will collect all the envelopes and make a single bank transfer for the total amount of donations.
